



STANDING PLGC COMMITTEES

Like the perennials in our gardens, PLGC Standing Committees are “keepers” that come back year after year.*

1. **BYLAWS** — Oversees the amendment process for PLGC bylaws and acts as an advisor to the Board regarding Parliamentary Procedure.
2. **FINANCE** — Oversees the annual budget process and proposes a budget to the board and members in February for a March vote.
3. **HISTORIAN** — Documents the history of PLGC by collecting programs, photos and other mementos of club activities for the club’s permanent record.
4. **MEMBERSHIP** — Encourages Plantation Lakes residents to consider membership in PLGC, acts as a liaison with prospective members and oversees the process for becoming a new member; maintains a permanent record of member information.
5. **NOMINATIONS** — Oversees the biennial nominating process and proposes a slate of officers to the board and members in February of odd-numbered years for a March vote.
6. **PROGRAMS** — Plans and implements programs and activities that promote home gardening, community beautification, floral design, horticulture, conservation and other topics of interest to members; maintains a permanent record of program information.
7. **WAYS AND MEANS** — Conducts fundraising activities that promote PLGC objectives and provide revenue for community service projects, donations to other organizations, and expenses that are approved by a majority vote of the Board.

SPECIAL PLGC COMMITTEES (2021-2022)

Like the annuals in our gardens, PLGC Special Committees may change annually or even seasonally.*

8. AWARDS (Mary Williford) — Identifies PLGC activities that may be eligible for a State, Regional or National award/grant and oversees the application process.
9. BLUE STAR MEMORIAL (Margaret Woda) — Organizes and oversees care of the Blue Star Memorial in front of the Plantation Lakes Community Center.
10. COMMUNITY BEAUTIFICATION
May Baskets (Betty Baeschlin) — Oversees the annual display of May Baskets in the community on May 1.
11. COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION (Debbie Darr) — Collaborates with other community organizations in Plantation Lakes to plan and conduct community events.
12. MEMBER HANDBOOK (Margaret Woda) — Prepares an annual reference guide (online or in print) for members that includes PLGC programs, projects, members, our affiliate organizations and other information.
13. NEWSLETTER (Mary Williford) — Prepares the monthly PLGC newsletter and submits information/photos to the DFGC and CAR-SGC newsletters upon request.
14. PENNY PINES (Mary Balasi) — Oversees PLGC participation in the NGC/USDA Forest Service partnership that helps to restore trees indigenous to an area destroyed by fire, flood or other natural catastrophe.
15. PUBLIC EDUCATION (Margaret Woda) — Conducts activities that promote our club objective to non-members in our community.
16. SCHOLARSHIP — Supports the DFGC scholarship program through the annual purchase of a DFGC Life Membership that is awarded to a PLGC member.
17. WEBSITE (Margaret Woda) — Shares information online with members, neighbors and others about PLGC activities.
18. YOUTH ACTIVITIES (Peggy Kircher) — Oversees PLGC activities that encourage children and teens to experience gardening and nature.
